Practice Overview

- I am a printmaker with an abiding interest in water bodies and deserts. I am particularly inspired by the aesthetic abstractions of mapping, water reflections and ripples.
- Like most artists I do a little of everything: I co-manage a printmaking studio (Stone & Quoin Studio at the 6 Manton Arts Hub in Hindmarsh), teach printmaking workshops as Union St Printmakers, mentor artists, curate exhibitions and organise print events. I am a member of the Print Council of Australia and Guildhouse, and a contact for Enjay Presses.
- I'm committed to sharing at a grass-roots level, bringing together contemporary practitioners, emerging artists, traditional craftspeople and the general community. My current focus is in facilitating group/collaborative printmaking folios, exhibitions and events; mentoring artists who are interested in printmaking; and running Stone & Quoin printmaking studio (with studio artists, an analogue darkroom and working letterpress and book arts facilities).

Over the past decade I have built up an extensive repertoire of courses in a variety of techniques,

as well as an excellent repository of books and support materials.

I have travelled to a variety of venues around Adelaide and in rural areas to teach many of these

workshops.

Techniques:

<u>Relief processes</u>: lino printing, repeat pattern stamping, introduction to fabric block printing, introduction to Japanese woodblock (mokuhanga) and wood engraving.

<u>Intaglio workshops</u>: drypoints, monoprinting, aluminium etching, beginners copper plate

etching, etching with aquatint, soft ground etching and chine colle.

Screenprinting workshops: beginners stencilling/screenprinting, screenprinting with UV emulsion & rubylith, UV screenprinting from hand drawn transparencies, UV screenprinting with digital transparencies, screenprinting with drawing/masking fluids, introduction to repeat pattern screenprinting and screen monoprinting.

Other: waterless lithography, collagraphs (both relief & intaglio), viscosity printing, printing-without-a-press (includes gelliplate printing), Japanese stab-binding, Suminagashi (Japanese marbling) and cyanotypes.
